Dear CIT Applicant:

Thank you for your interest in the Counselor in Training (C.I.T.) program. The purpose of this letter is to help both the applicant and parents understand more about the program and the YMCA's expectations. The C.I.T. Program is a specialized leadership program for older campers wanting to gain leadership skills. It provides a unique educational and practical challenge for those camps with leadership potential. C.I.T.'s will focus on listening to children, role modeling values, using positive discipline, teaching new skills, leading group games and building respect. Supervised by the camp directors, C.I.T.'s will develop their own personal strengths through leading children and serving as role models. Teens who are successful CITs will not necessarily be asked to volunteer or apply for a position as staff when they become 18 years of age.

In order to be considered, you must be at least 14 years of age but no older than 17 year of age by June 1, 2018. In addition, you must attend an individual interview with the camp directors. Being a C.I.T. is a commitment. You may sign up for any C.I.T. sessions; however we cannot guarantee space for all applicants to participate for ten weeks. For each C.I.T. session, space is limited, and not everyone who applies will be accepted. Five spaces are available for Fun Factory and five spaces are available for Camp Mac Boykin. Three references will be checked once you submit this application and attend the group interview. Please do not ask a Y staff member to be a reference for you; we will speak to Y directors who have known you.

Once accepted, you must complete the registration form and submit it to the YMCA's Member Service Desk. A deposit of \$5 is required to hold the space once you have been accepted into the camp. The fee for the each CIT program is \$30 for members and \$45 for potential members.
